Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 Drive from Delhi to Shimla (330 km/approx. 9 hours)

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

Board the booked vehicle after arrival at the Delhi airport/railway station and proceed towards Shimla. Being the summer capital of India under British rule, this hill station is noted for its scenic views and lush greenery. Referred to as the 'Queen of the hills', it is bestowed with lofty mountain peaks, peaceful environs, fresh mountain air and a bustling Mall Road.

On the way to this destination, get soaked in the tranquillity and admire the meandering streets, sparkling rivers and the lush greenery. After arriving at this destination, check-in at the hotel and rest for a while.

Spend the rest of the day at leisure in the hotel room.

Day 2 Trip to Kufri

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

After enjoying a sound sleep, leave the hotel and head towards a tour to Kufri. The name of this destination is derived from 'Kufri', which means a lake. Set amidst snow-capped mountains, this hill station offers splendid views of the surroundings. Along with natural beauty, this place also hosts various adventure sport activities, including skiing and trekking.

Mahasu Peak is the highest peak in Kufri, which can be climbed by a pony ride. This peak offers a mesmerising view of the snow-clad mountains and glaciers. Also, there is Himalayan Wildlife Zoo, which is widely appreciated by wildlife buffs.

After completing the sightseeing, retire to the hotel in Shimla and enjoy an overnight stay.

Day 3 Trip to Naldehra

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

In the morning, leave the hotel and drive towards Naldehra, which lies at an altitude of 2044 m above sea level. A haven for tourists, this destination is famous for the oldest 9-hole golf course in India. This place derives its name from the Nag Temple situated here. Another known attraction at this place is Tattapani, which is at an altitude of 656 m above sea level and is known for its hot sulphur springs that are known for their medicinal value. The scenic beauty of this place is simply mesmerising and that is the reason why hordes of travellers visit here.

After sightseeing in this beautiful destination, return to the hotel in Shimla and rest for some time. Thereafter, spend the evening strolling along the famous Mall Road, which is dotted with numerous handicrafts shops and food outlets.

Later, return to the hotel and enjoy a good night's sleep

Day 4 Drive from Shimla to Manali (270 km/approx. 9 hours)

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

Wake up rejuvenated and proceed towards Manali. This hill station's serene environment and pleasant weather makes it a heavenly kingdom for newly wed couples. The fresh mountain air of this hill station is rejuvenating and believed to be very healthy. Some of the hotspots of this place that are visited by tourists include Solang Valley, Manali Sanctuary, Hadimba Temple and Pandoh Dam. This place, rich in flora and fauna, attracts a large number of nature enthusiasts and wildlife lovers.

After arrival in Manali, check-in at the hotel and rest for some time. You can spend the day at leisure staying at the hotel room or can go out for sightseeing.

Retire to the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 5 Trip to Rohtang Pass

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

Soon after getting ready, leave the hotel and proceed towards Rohtang Pass. This is a high mountain pass that connects the Kullu Valley with the Lahaul and Spiti Valleys of Himachal Pradesh. To add a fun factor to the vacation, you can take part in adventure sport activities, including skiing, mountaineering and trekking. Situated on the eastern Pir Panjal Range of the Himalayas, this place serves as an ideal picnic spot.

After touring this place, return to the hotel and freshen up. In the evening, go for a leisure walk in the popular Mall Road. This road, dotted with colonial buildings, handicrafts shops, branded outlets and eateries, is the best place to spend some leisure time.

Retire to the hotel and enjoy a good night's sleep.

Day 6 Sightseeing in Manali

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

Welcome a beautiful morning and proceed for the sightseeing tour of Manali. Snow-capped mountains, dense deodar forests, serene environment and friendly local people brings this hill station on the list of top holiday destinations. If not just interested in sightseeing, you can also take part in various adventure sports, including rafting, skiing, mountaineering and trekking.

Among the prominent places comes the Manali Wildlife Sanctuary, which is the home to some of the endangered species, namely leopard, brown bear, musk deer, monal and many more. Watching animals enjoying in their natural habitat is a delightful experience. Also, Hadimba Temple is visited by hordes of tourists all round the year. Nestled amidst dense coniferous forests, this temple has a beautiful three roof structure constructed using timber tiles.

Spend the evening at leisure, resting at the hotel room. Stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 7 Drive from Manali to Chandigarh (325 km/approx. 8 hours)

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

After checking-out from the hotel in Manali, drive towards Chandigarh. Widely appreciated for its cleanliness and greenery, this city witness a large influx of tourists all year-round. Explore this destination and visit the exclusive Rock Garden. This garden displays artefacts, made using industrial and urban waste.

Also, there are various artificial waterfalls, which make the place even more entertaining to visit.

Upon arrival in Chandigarh, complete the check-in formalities at the hotel and relax in your room for some time. Thereafter, you may go on a sightseeing trip of the city to visit its popular attractions, such as Capitol Complex, Sukhna Lake, Rock Garden and Open Hand.

Capitol Complex is a government building that was designed by the great Le Corbusier. It is situated in Sector 1 of Chandigarh and houses buildings of the High Court, the Secretariat and the Legislative Assembly. Earlier, it was the seat of the Punjab Government; however today, it is the headquarters of both the governments of Haryana and Punjab. Some time back, there were speculations to build a fourth building as part of the Capitol Complex and was to be named Raj Bhavan; however, no concrete steps have been taken in this regard. The three buildings in this complex have a splendid architecture and are symbolism of the city's fast growth in recent years.

The man-made Sukhna Lake, situated at the foothills of the Shivalik range, has a 3-km shoreline. It was built in the year 1958, after a dam was built across a seasonal stream - Sukhna Choe that flowed from the Shivalik hills. The highlight of this place is its beautiful surroundings and cool breeze, making it a popular picnic spot. Sport activities, like water skiing, yachting and boating are on offer at this lake.

Built by Nek Chand, an artist and former road inspector of the Chandigarh Engineering Department, Rock Garden is a masterpiece that was formed from urban and industrial waste. Established as an open-air exhibition hall, it houses many items made porcelain, metal wires, auto parts, mudguards, frames, etc.

Open Hand is a 14-metre high and 50 tonne structure that was designed by Le Corbusier. Made of metal sheets, this giant hand symbolises unity and peace and serves as the emblem of the city of Chandigarh.

Alternatively, you can pay a visit to its famous markets, such as the shopping arcade of Sector 17, also called as as the City Centre.

Return to the hotel in the evening and stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 8 Drive from Chandigarh to Delhi (250 km/approx. 5 hours)

Meals:Meals as per hotel plan

Wake up in the morning and drive towards Delhi, culminating his unforgettable journey.
